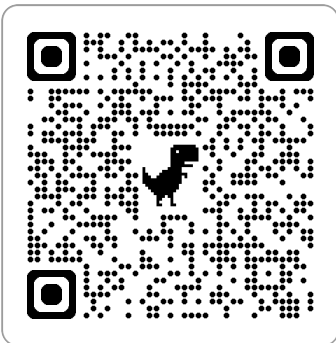
WELCOME

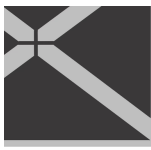




